Under the Further Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Reguitements Act of 2018 (Pub. L. 115-123), the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) allocated \$8.285 billion for mitigation activities and assistance to the Government of Puerto Rico under the Community Development Block Grant-Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) Program. The CDBG-MIT Program is a unique opportunity to promote long-term recovery and resiliency within Puerto Rico's most vulnerable communities through activities aimed at mitigating disaster risks and reducing future losses. The Puerto Rico Department of Housing (PRDOH) is the local grantee agency in charge of the CDBG-MIT Program administration and implementation. In accordance with the CDBG-MIT Action Plan, PRDOH created the Multi-Sector Community Mitigation Program (MSC-MIT) Program which will consider mitigation needs of communities living in high-risk areas. PathStone Corporation has received a Subaward, to perform the program management, oversight execution, and delivery of Program's activities in accordance with PRDOH guidelines, HUD guidelines and regulations, and other applicable state and federal laws and regulations. As part of the responsibilities, PathStone will support the processes of design by facilitating participatory workshops, presentations, and meetings to involve community members in the design process.

The Small Purchase process is a competitive procurement process to select a qualified professional or professional firm to provide the services. The potential proponents interested in obtaining the Small Purchase package must write an email to <u>JuAlvarez@pathstone.org</u>.

Responses to this Small Purchase should be prepared in accordance with the instructions provided in the SOW. The Proposals will be evaluated and awarded by PathStone per their procurement policies. Prior to awarding a contract, PathStone must obtain contractor clearance. To obtain clearance, PathStone will search https://www.sam.gov/SAM/ to verify whether the contractor is or not debarred using the Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS). PROPONENTS MUST POSSESS A DUNS NUMBER AND BE REGISTERED IN THE SYSTEM FOR AWARD MANAGEMENT (SAM) AT THE TIME OF THE PROPOSAL SUBMISSION OR INITIATE THE REGISTRATION **PROCESS RIGHT AFTER** THE PROPOSAL SUBMISSION.
